- North Star BH is working with ASPC to put out "A Season of Hope & Lights" initiative. A family & community MH/BH resource. should come out in the next few weeks. I'll get info to Stephanie as it develops
- Donna can be available to help with any type of city support
- Ninilchik has funding available to connect frontline workers to BH services, this includes folks who work in the medical or behavioral health field not only for hospital workers

4. Work Group Updates:

- a. Prevention Work Group
 - i. Continues to work on the partial fill for opioids at the pharmacy level. Surveys have been sent out to some pharmacies that agreed to participate, however no responses have been collected yet. COVID related staffing issues have been expressed as an obstacle for pharmacy participation at this time. Working on communication with the Alaska Medicaid Pharmacy Services for public PSAs regarding partial fill.
 - ii. Has started to work on the Alternative Pain Management Pathway. This will be a 3-part project, with handouts directed at Providers (with evidence of why these alternatives can treat physical pain) and for patients to understand this connection as well. Additionally, there will be an addition to the website that will include local resources for these alternative services.

b. Treatment Work Group

- i. Detox Conversation (Next conversation, 12/9)
- ii. Updating Treatment Resources
 - Continues to assess the updated treatment resources on the Southern Kenai Peninsula. Discussed the importance of keeping the monthly meeting primarily focused on this aspect especially during COVID. The group stated that this group has been particularly important in navigating treatment during COVID and is looking at highlighting quarantine projects within the state to help streamline access to treatment.

5. Other Updates

- a. Discussion about the use of the Bridge Device, especially during COVID. Stephanie will reach out to the Fairbanks Opioid Task Force to discuss how they are implementing the use of these devices in their community, to start to assess need for our community to have additional funding for these.
- 6. Closing Thoughts: No meeting in December, however there will be work group meetings.
